<b>Moved Goods</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Passport</li> <li>DA 304, PI 160 &amp; CA101;</li> <li>Temporary/Permanent Proof of Residence</li> </ul>	If items over 12 months old, entry is duty-free.	<p>If temporary Residence Permit not in hand - copy of letter of appointment by employer required.</p> <p><b>IMPORTANT:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As most goods are cleared through customs in the Rep. of South Africa, (due to Swaziland being land -locked), then South African customs formalities are applied and accepted by the Swaziland customs authorities as they share a common customs union agreement.</li> <li>Non-Swaziland residents can only apply for a temporary residence permit, which is valid for between 2 -5 years, depending on the length of the contract with their employer in Swaziland, and the discretion of the Swaziland Government.</li> </ol>
<b>Diplomatic goods</b>	Certificate from the Diplomats' office.	Entry is free from duties.	
<b>Bridal Clothes</b>	Invoice required.	Liable to payment of duties.	
<b>Heirlooms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Copy of Will of deceased or certified relevant extract there from or copy of Probate from the Court, if the deceased died interstate. An English translation is necessary if document is not in English.</li> <li>Inventory (if copy will or other document does not specifically detail the goods to be imported) with supporting declaration from the lawyer confirming that the goods to be imported are the legatee's rightful share of the estate.</li> <li>Declaration from the legatee proving that he is a permanent resident of Swaziland and a beneficiary under the will of the dead.</li> </ul>	Entry is free from duty provided that legatee is temporarily/permanently residing in Swaziland.	The items should not be dispatched until the customs have given authority for duty free entry.

<b>New furniture household items, gifts and Memorabilia</b>		Liable to payment of full duties.	
<b>Artwork , antiquity</b>		Entry is free from duties provided: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Works of art are forming a part of a Bona Fide Household removal, or</li> <li>•Articles are more than 100 years old</li> <li>•These articles have been in the use and possession of the owner for more than 1 year and</li> <li>•Are not for sale or other disposal for 6 months after entry.</li> </ul>	
<b>Valued metal articles</b>		Duty free entry is allowed on the same basis and under the same conditions as furniture and other articles.	
<b>Motorcars, motor cycles, mopeds, power driven boats with inboard engines</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Customs Form C104/A</li> <li>•Document showing that the vehicle has been in the owner's use and possession abroad for more than 1 year before the importation of the vehicle (original purchase invoice, insurance certificate, etc.).</li> </ul>	Entry is free from duties provided:  The vehicles (cars, motor cycles, mopeds) will not be sold or otherwise disposed of for 24 months after the date of importation.	Only 1 car per family is permitted.
<b>Caravans, trailers</b>		Liable to payment of duties.	
<b>Dogs, cats, birds</b>		Import licence is granted after the owner has made arrangements for the period of quarantine with a licensed kennel.	
<b>Plants and vegetable products</b>	Phytosanitary certificate.	Entry is free from duties.	
<b>Dangerous objects, weapons</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Valid firearm certificate</li> <li>•Import licence issued to the owner by the Police authorities.</li> </ul>	Entry is free from duties.	
<b>Narcotics, drugs, incitements</b>		Importation not allowed.	
<b>Pornographic books and</b>		Importation not allowed.
